

## 10 Commandments of Youth Camp

8. Think pure and good thoughts and don't bring any swearing, dirty talk or dirty jokes onto the grounds.
9. No halter tops, tank tops or sleeveless tops. All culottes, jams or shorts must come within 3" (inches) of your knees (dresses and skirts must go to the middle of the knee).
