

# Camper Orientation

## 1. Welcome:

I want to welcome you to Lily Lake Youth Camp. How many of you are here for the first time at LLYC?

Our facilities aren't the best in the world. But, you will find this week packed with adults who love you and a schedule of things that you will enjoy. And you will be glad you came here.

## 2. INTRODUCTIONS:

I'm Pastor Frank Skies. I'm the camp Director.

Also, there are many counselors around this camp ground that you can talk to if you need something.

We are all here to help and aid you! Remember that. **HOWEVER**, if all of you were to come to me with every problem, I'd only have time for problems. If you have a problem, the first person you see is your team leader or cabin counselor. If they aren't around, then find any counselor. If they cannot help you, they will direct you to your coordinator. If your coordinator cannot help you, he or she will direct you to me. If you come to me with a problem, I'm probably going to ask you if you have seen your coordinator.

## 3. TEAMS & POINTS:

In order to make this week run more smoothly, we have divided you up into teams. You will find out what those teams are at the end of orientation.

Everything done here is done by teams. We have chores every day, and they're done by teams. We play sports by teams. We have afterglow's by teams.

We keep points by teams. The winners of the sports get prizes at the end of the week. You can get 100 points for every game you win. 50 for every game you tie. You can get points for helping out in areas where something needs carried, or someone needs help. You can get points from the Evangelist for helping him or her in some extra way. The cabin of the day gets 50 points per person on each team.

Another wonderful way to get points is to participate in the Thursday night talent contest. Each person on your team who manifests their true talent gets 25 points. The winner gets 100 points for their team.

**HOWEVER**, there are also ways to lose points. You can lose points by being late to services- 10 demerits. You can lose points for being absent for class or worship- 25 demerits. You can lose points for skipping work detail-10 demerits.
